This year's *Elements* exhibition shows the development of British silver design from the post war austerity of the 1940s and 1950s to the design revolution that blossomed in the 1960s and the decades that followed. Each decade is represented by ten pieces from *The Pearson Silver Collection*, plus a further sixty objects. The Pearson Silver Collection is devoted to Post World War II British designer silver and is the largest collection of its kind in private hands.
