

tanzil fidda – Jüdisches Metallhandwerk in Damaskus

HammerClub received an announcement of Klaus-Dieter Eichler, in which he offers the book *tanzil fidda – Jewish Metal-craft in Damascus*. This catalogue was published in conjunction with an exhibition in the Jüdischen Museum Fürth, the Museum für Frühislamische Kunst Bamberg and the Synagoge of Ermreuth in 1995. The book describes the art of inlaying (silver or copper in brass, or copper in silver) and is based on research performed in 1992 in Damascus.

The Pagma Verlag has taken over the rest of the stock and offers the book for € 5 (+ shipping).
